**Oregon Inventor to Exhibit “LoopRope™” at  
America’s Largest Invention Show**

**PITTSBURGH...** InventHelp's INPEX®, America's Largest Invention TradeShow, announces that inventor, Jeffery Dahl, from Medford, Oregon, has invented a product that features one continuous bungee cord of varying lengths fastened together in such a manner that creates permanent loops that serve as different attachment points. When used with the double gated carabineers, or clips of your choice, it makes LoopRope™ the most versatile light to medium duty tie-down device one would ever own. This invention will be exhibited at INPEX® 2010, June 16-18, in Pittsburgh.

We all find there are those times in our lives when we need tie-down devices for our cars, trucks, RV's, ATV's, Boats, campsites or even backyards. When we're moving, when we're transporting awkwardly-shaped items or even when we're packed to the gills for a road trip, regular bungee cords are never the right size and the hooks can be unsafe. Sometimes we need our tie-down devices to be a little more versatile, safe and supportive by having a little more length or a little less length and just do all the different things we sometimes need them to do. This inventor thought of an idea called "LoopRope™", a multi-functioning, quickly adjustable, and safe tie-down device that virtually covers every application that had previously required use of a specific sized bungee or inconvenient ratchet strap.

LoopRope™ consists of bungee material permanently fastened together to create loops the whole length of the rope, similar to a single strand of cargo net, yet stronger and adjustable. LoopRope™ is sold with two 75 pound rated double-gated carabineers which allow for secure fastening at any loop. LoopRope™ features "linkability", because of the ability to combine several ropes it enables the user to create a cargo net but where they need it. There is no knot tying required, no ratcheting devices to rust or fail and best of all one size fits all. LoopRope™ is producible in any color and can be used for many purposes, such as tying down a tarp on a trailer to tying up gear on a camping trip. Boaters are using the multifunction aspect to both tie to the dock and securely hang their buoys. Rafters use them to clip off their gear, and LoopRope™ is great for plumbers and electricians to use to secure their pipes to their racks. The possibilities and uses are endless.

The inventor was inspired to think of his invention because of a personal experience. "I was trying to untie a knot on a rope I used to tie down a tarp," said Dahl. "I thought there had to be a better way. At that moment, I thought, "why not have a rope with tie-off points the full length of the rope?" I went straight to a boat store, bought a rope and tied trucker hitch knots all the way down the rope and started using it." LoopRope™ can solve all fastening challenges no matter what the situation.
